



Koyotes fall late in Iowa

The Kansas Koyotes suffered their first loss of the American Professional Football League season on the road Saturday night, with the Iowa Blackhawks rallying from a 15-point fourth-quarter deficit to stun the Koyotes, 34-31 in Council Bluffs.
