

## Blackhawks finally win in Kansas, 55-35

TOPEKA, Kan. - The streak is over.

For the first time ever, the Iowa Blackhawks beat Kansas on the road in an APFL game, winning 55-35 Saturday at Landon Arena.

Mell Holliday scored 4 touchdowns, and Chuck Wright threw three touchdown passes as the Blackhawks' offense played mistake-free football for most of the evening. The Iowa defense played inspirationally throughout the contest, forcing four Koyote turnovers, including a 25-yard interception return by Travis Hines to seal the victory.

Holliday rushed for 84 yards on 20 carries, and Wright completed 14 of 18 passes for 163 yards, as the Blackhawks took control of the contest in the second half after a 21-21 tie at halftime. Iowa led 42-21 early in the fourth quarter with an interception by Scott Yates and fumble recovery by Jeff McQuinn stopping Kansas drives to give Iowa momentum.

The play of the game though, occurred when Hines stepped in front of a Carlos Kelly pass and raced untouched to the end zone with less than 10 minutes remaining to put it out of reach at 49-28. Holliday added a 1-yard score with just seconds left to cap the scoring.

The Blackhawks have until June 6 before they play again, when they entertain the Mid-Missouri Outlaws at the Mid-America Center.
